Both Officer Eull and K9 Frees underwent extensive training in North Carolina. Upon their arrival in Madison, they hit the streets and become members of the K9 team.



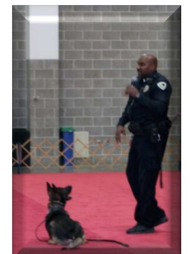
## K9 Martie Helps Locate Illegal Drugs
